

Edmond Women's Club Ambassador Program Application 2017-2018

Mission

The mission of the Edmond Women's Club Ambassadors Program is to educate through experience and motivate young leaders and enable them to take an active role in their community. This will result in strong leaders who have hope for the future and the tools to influence a positive and progressive community.

Program Description

Approximately 10-15 high school junior and senior women from the Edmond area are selected for Edmond Women's Club Ambassadors. The class will attend community service projects beginning in September 2017 with Edmond Women's Club members in the Edmond community. The students will be honored at a special recognition meeting and dinner with their parents and/or legal guardians on April 12, 2018.

Application Requirements

- Applicants must be high school juniors or seniors for the 2017-2018 school year.
- Applicants must live in Edmond (as defined by their street address) or attend school (public or private) in Edmond.
- Applicants must have at least a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential and have a sincere commitment, motivation, and desire to serve in the Edmond Community.
- Please provide a photo.
- Please include a letter of recommendation from an adult who knows you well but is not a parent or relative. For example: ask a teacher, youth group leader, club advisor, coach, employer or neighbor. This letter should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the EWC application.

Selection Process

1. The application, photo, and letter of recommendation must be sent to: **Edmond Women's Club, Attention: Ambassador Program Chair, PO Box 3046, Edmond, OK 73083, and postmarked by Monday, August 28, 2017.**

3. The Selection Committee will review only complete applications submitted by the deadline.
4. Ambassadors will be notified of their selection by September 7, 2017.

Program Requirements

1. Ambassadors are required to complete 10 hours of designated Edmond Women's Club community service projects between September 2017 and April 12, 2018. A schedule of Community Service projects will be provided. Some community service projects could involve evenings or weekends, but Ambassadors may choose which projects they would like to complete from the schedule. Detailed requirements will be provided at the informational meeting.
2. Attendance is required at the Informational Meeting and the Edmond Women's Club General Meeting on September 14, 2017, and the Recognition meeting and dinner on April 12, 2018.
3. Please note that participation is limited to one term to maximize the number of students that are able to participate.
